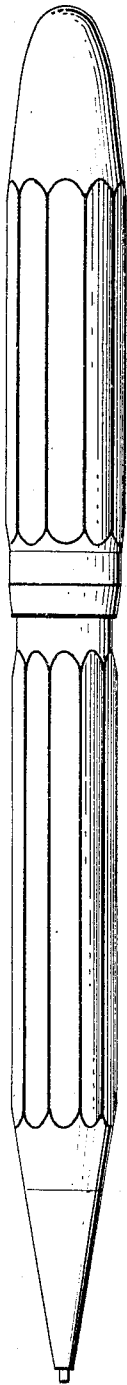

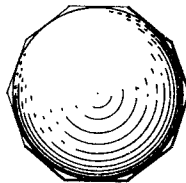

DESIGN FOR A PENCIL

Application filed July 13, 1931. Serial No. 40,523. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ANDREAS BIENENSTEIN, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pencil, and of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, wherein

Figure 1 is an elevational view of a pencil showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is an enlarged top end view.

The essential or dominant features of my new design consist in the barrel portions of different diameters whereby the portion of larger diameter simulates a fountain pen cap, together with the combination of the contour of the pencil with the series of longitudinally extending circumferentially arranged flat surfaces providing panels.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pencil substantially as shown and described.
